One things that really is amazing, is that no one from Hollywood has made Max's life into a movie...yet!

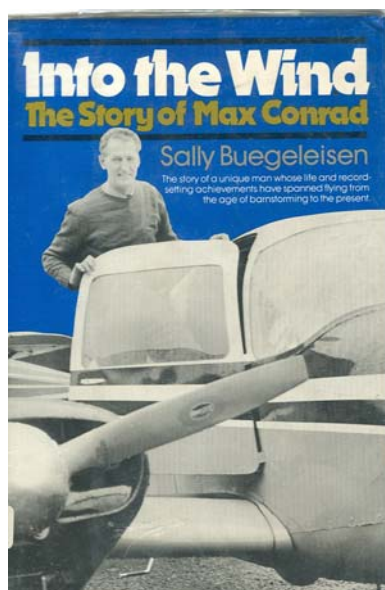
