EAA Chapter 919 Meeting

November 16, 2007

The meeting was held at Winona Airport and called to order by President Ossell at 7:05 PM.

Treasurer reported there was \$2389.72 in the bank. The only activity in the past month was the \$100 check to Mrs. Daniels.

Minutes of the October meeting were approved as read.

The nominating committee reported that the present officers have agreed to stand for re-election for 2008. In order to have contests for officers, the following also agreed to run: President – Mike Thern, Vice President – Dan Bass, Treasurer – Dr. Jerry Smith, Secretary – Al Berg. Nominating Committee member, Russ Marsolek emphasized that the present officers have done excellent jobs in 2007, that there is absolutely no criticism of their performance, but that a choice is always good.

Meeting adjourned at 8:05 PM.

Discussion items included:

Dave McCorquedale's Capella Aircraft received its DAR inspection and Airworthiness Certificate November 10. Congratulations, Dave!

Mrs. Daniels sent a thank you to the club. Russ suggested that next summer a "Memorial Flight" in honor of Kevin be held at the Rushford Airport, a place Kevin considered very special in its hospitality for flyers.

December meeting to be held on December 14 – the 2nd Friday – instead of on the 3rd Friday, at the Mike and Barb Thern residence at 750 W Burns Valley Rd, Winona. This will be a plate-to-pass meal/holiday party.

Poker Run was suggested for Saturday, December 15, the day after the holiday party. Any "leftovers" will be taken to the Rushford Airport.

Mike Thern mentioned the EAA will be holding Chapter Training Session in January in Osh Kosh and suggested the club officers consider attending. The training aims to increase aviation activity.

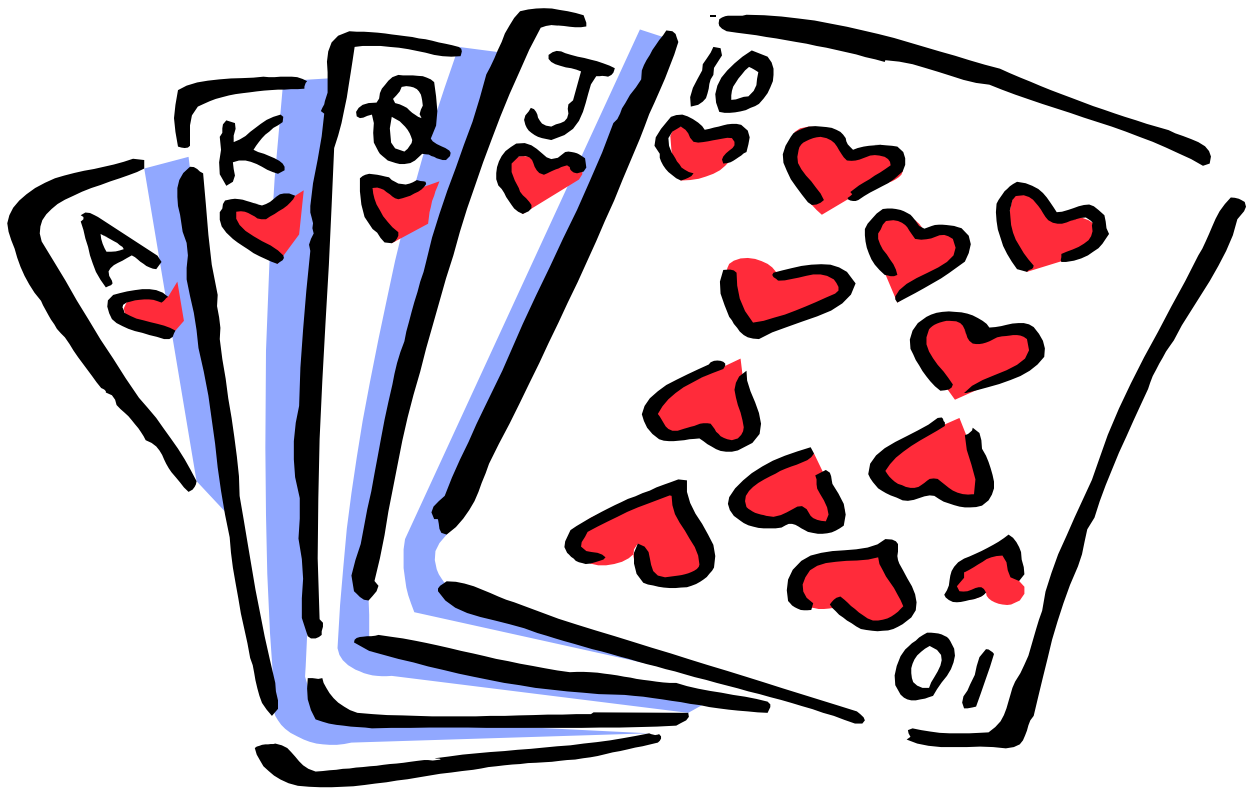
Winter Fly-Ins will include Famous Dave's at Hayward in late January and Log Cabin at Eleva in Mid-February.

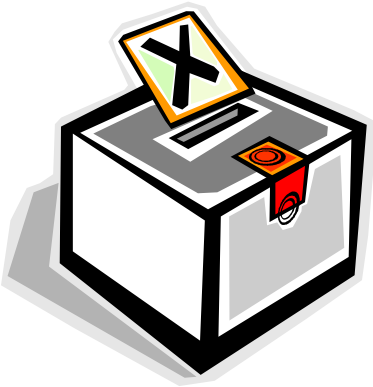
