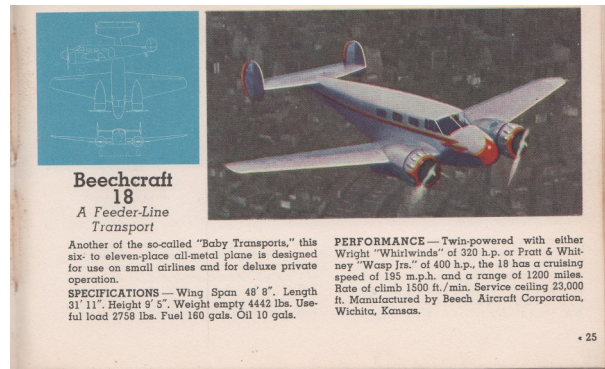

With a heads-up about these requirements, a person can make appropriate choices about medical care and lifestyle to ensure obtaining and maintaining their medical. If you haven't yet used the new "MedXpress.FAA.gov," you need to learn how to use this new system of filling out your medical history online prior to your doctor visit.
